

PNHS Day Trip to Arran 21st August 2026

We are planning a day trip to Arran with the timetable detailed below. Can you [let us know](#) if you would be interested in attending.

Craig Postlethwaite will be leading the walk. The plan is to do it all by public transport as cars would need to be booked on the ferry well in advance and if the weather is not suitable for spending all day outside then we would cancel the trip.

The itinerary allows us to visit a few different habitats. It's not strenuous walking although the Sannox loop is maybe a little bumpy.

08:44 Leave Paisley Gilmour Street on train to Ardrossan Harbour. Arrive 09:22

09:45 Ferry Departs – watch for seabirds & cetaceans during crossing

10:40 Ferry Arrives

10:55 Depart on 324 Bus from Ferry terminal.

11:18 Arrive Glen Sannox. Do Glen Sannox loop walk of around 1.5miles in heathland and moor for plants, birds, invertebrates.

13:06 324 bus back to Brodick Castle

13:20 Arrive Brodick Castle. – Cafe, toilets. Woodland walks with birds, lichens, plants.

15:59 Depart Brodick castle on 324 bus to Ferry terminal.

16:40 Ferry departs – again watch for seabirds & cetaceans.

17:35 Arrive Ardrossan.

17:49 Train to Paisley Departs

18:30 Arrive back at Gilmour Street

Standard train fare from Paisley is £9.20, Ferry return for an adult passenger is £10.60. Discounts may apply depending on age etc.

As always, dress appropriately for the weather and terrain.
